PLAYER RULES

To attend practice/play at the Payneham Clubrooms following the COVID-19 lockdown you must comply with the following rules. These adhere to the Government's directives and guidelines, the TTA and TTSA's recommendations and the Payneham Academy and District Table Tennis Club's instructions.

Do not attend the Clubrooms if you are feeling unwell, especially with cold, flu or COVID-19 symptoms.

Do not attend the Clubrooms if you have returned from overseas in the last month.

Upon arrival – sanitise your hands (available near the front door).

Sign in at the Group Leader's desk by **printing** your name and contact details on the **Sign in Register** on the desk. Your signature on this form signifies your willingness to abide by the club's return to play rules.

Pay your playing fees prior to playing any games. The fee is \$2.00 per session. Use gold coins or notes only (no shrapnel) and place in the money container on the Session Leader's desk.

Bring your own water bottle.

Kitchen facilities can be used. This includes refrigerator, microwave, sandwich maker and toaster oven and hot and cold water but if you want tea, coffee, biscuits, etc bring your own plus crockery to drink/eat from. If you eat/drink at a table in the dining area or elsewhere in the clubrooms you are responsible for wiping it down afterwards.

Club seating has been re-organized to maintain social distancing of 1.5 metres. Do not move chairs from their current locations.

Toilets can be used but only two people in each of the Male and Female toilets at any time. Use hand sanitizer following use of toilets.

Use the COVID Safe App if possible. It is recommended that you have the COVID-Safe app on your phone and make sure it is activated upon entering the Clubrooms. This can help track Covid-19 cases if they arise in the community and ensure we know who has been near the infected person.

PLAYING RULES

Bring and use your own bat. No bats will be available at the Clubrooms for players to borrow.

NO handshaking, high fives or deliberate physical contact during games.

Hand sanitizer is situated at the entry to each of the courts. Use this frequently.

When not playing, keep all your gear – towels, any clothing, cleaning cloths, bats, balls and drinks – in your own bag. Maintain social distancing when you are not playing.

Enter and leave individual courts through the gaps in barriers as set up by Session Leader prior to the start of the session. Move barriers as little as possible. Avoid touching table surfaces. If your sweat drops onto the table you must wipe down the table surface using the cleaning materials provided by The PTTA.

The players using a particular table at the end of the day's session are responsible for wiping it down using the cleaning materials provided by The PTTA. (For the time being we have discontinued covering the tables).

All frequently touched surfaces need to be cleaned at the end of the session. The Group Leader is responsible for getting this done so if your Group Leader asks for assistance with this or any other task please help them. Remember that the Covid-19 precautions are designed to protect the health of all members but have made the Group Leader role more onerous.
